In pursuance of its functions under the above-mentioned Acts, the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ **A/1958/83** dated **25/8/83** decided to refuse:

For **Proposed sign at Rathcoole Shopping Mall, Main St., Rathcoole.**

for the following reasons:

1. The proposed sign which is located close to the road edge would interfere with pedestrians and with cars turning into the parking area of the shopping mall and hence would result in a traffic hazard and a danger to public safety.

**NOTE:** The applicant is advised to consult with the Council's Roads Department with a view to identifying a possible site for the sign.

NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala by the applicant within one month from the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1. An Appeal lodged by an applicant or sent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (2) A party to an appeal making a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral Hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten Pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
