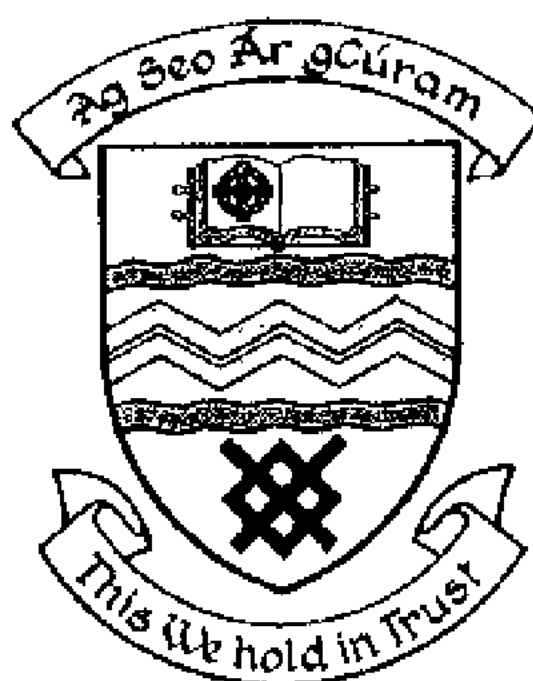

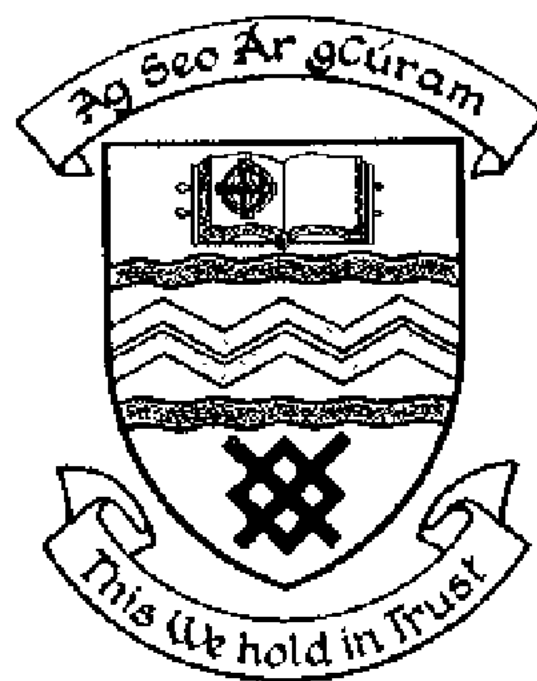

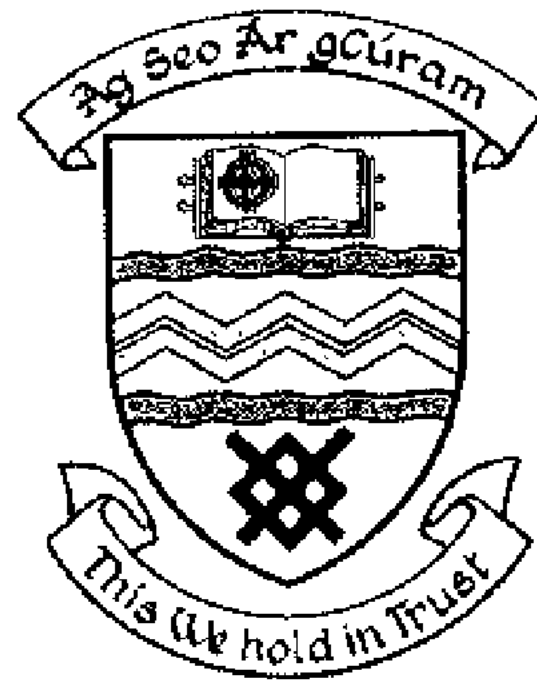

**Conditions and Reasons**

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.  
REASON:  
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 That the entire premises be used as a single dwelling unit.  
REASON:  
To prevent unauthorised development.
- 3 That all external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing premises.  
REASON:  
In the interest of visual amenity.
- 4 That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.  
REASON:  
In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
- 5 That the footpath and kerb be dished and drained to the requirements of the Planning Authority (Roads Department). All works to be carried out at the expense of the applicant.  
REASON:  
In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
- 6 That the design materials and finishes of gate piers and boundary wall harmonise with existing development.  
REASON:  
In the interest of visual amenity.
