APPEAL by Louis Fitzgerald of Tootenhill, Rathcoole, County Dublin against the decision made on the 18th day of August, 1983, by the Council of the County of Dublin to refuse permission for the retention of an advertising sign at the "Poition Still", Tootenhill, Rathcoole, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1983, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said advertising sign for the reason set out in the Schedule hereto.

The retention of this sign, by reason of its excessive size, illumination, prominence and location adjacent to the junction of main street and the National Primary Route, causes an unacceptable distraction to motorists thereby endangering public safety by reason of a traffic hazard.

for the following reasons:

1. The ~~max~~ retention of this sign by reason of its excessive size, illumination, prominence and location adjacent to the junction of Main Street and the NE N7 Primary Route would cause an unacceptable distraction to traffic thereby endangering public safety by reason of a traffic hazard.

NOTE: The applicant is advised that more favourable consideration may be given to a proposal for a sign which is non-illuminated and significantly reduced in size ~~from that existing~~ from that existing on the site. The applicant is advised to consult with the Planning Authority prior to the submission of any further planning application for a sign on this site.

NOTE: (1) An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala by the applicant within one month from the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Lower Abbey Street, Dublin 1. An Appeal lodged by an applicant or agent with An Bord Pleanala will be invalid unless accompanied by a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (2) A party to an appeal making a request to An Bord Pleanala for an oral Hearing of an appeal must, in addition to (1) above, pay to An Bord Pleanala a fee of £30 (Thirty Pounds). (3) A person who is not a party to an appeal must pay a fee of £10 (Ten Pounds) to An Bord Pleanala in relation to an appeal. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
