

#### Reasons

- The proposed development which proposes to use an existing access which is narrow and has inadequate vision splays onto the Lucan-Newlands Road would, by the generation of additional traffic turning movements, endanger public safety by way of traffic hazard.
- The inability of the proposed development to connect into the existing foul and surface water sewers to the south of the site and the proposal to provide a biocycle effluent treatment system to serve the dwelling is deemed to be inappropriate within this urban area and therefore would be prejudicial to public health and contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The absence of the written evidence of the applicant's ownership of the site to which the application refers and the absence of plans and elevation drawings of the proposed storage shed and the main features of the dwellings adjoining the site, render the details submitted with the application inadequate to facilitate a proper assessment and the proposal is therefore contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.

Dear Sir/Madam, with reference to your planning application, received on 30/09/98 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning & Development) Acts 1963-1993, the following ADDITIONAL INFORMATION must be submitted in quadruplicate:

- The applicant to submit written evidence (in the form of a land registry map) of ownership of the entirety of the site as outlined in colour on the submitted site location map. If the site boundary on the land registry map differs from that submitted on the site location map then either evidence of right of way across other lands to the site or consent from the respective landowner will be required.
- The proposed vehicular access has restricted vision and additional traffic at this point would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard. The road frontage of the site is too narrow to improve the vision splay an acceptable distance. The applicant to be asked whether or not she can provide for an alternative access to the site with improved vision lines.

- The applicant to submit details of investigations regarding connection into the foul and surface water sewers in the estate to the south. The applicant is advised that the site immediately to the south negotiated a connection to the said sewers. The possibility of using these connections might be examined.
- Applicant to submit detailed plans, elevation drawings, cross-section and specification for the conversion of the existing derelict dwelling into a storage area. In view of the poor structural condition of the building the applicant to confirm whether demolition and new build, rather than conversion will be required.
- Applicant to submit a front elevation drawing with the main features of the existing dwellings on either side of the site thereon. The overall heights of the buildings to be given.

NOTE: The applicant is advised of the Planning Authority's concern that the proposed two storey design will be out of character with the existing dwellings in the immediate vicinity.
