Reasons

- The proposed house would be substandard by reason of inadequate separation from the existing dwelling. The proposed separation is less than 1 metre whereas the Development Plan requires 2.3 metres.
- The proposed house has a building line of 1 metre from the adjoining boundary with the Local Distributor Road. As such the proposed development would be visually intrusive and constitute disorderly development and would seriously injure the amenities and depreciate the value of property in the vicinity. This situation would be aggravated by the difference in ground level between the site and adjoining footpath and the provision of a chimney in the gable.
- The proposed development would contravene materially the zoning objective for the area, which is "To protect and improve residential amenity", and would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed house would be located within 5 metres of a 200mm diameter watermain which is the minimum required by the Environmental Services Engineer. Again the differences in ground levels would aggravate the situation. As such the proposed development would be prejudicial to public health.


