REASON: To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 Prior to the development commencing the applicant shall submit the following for the agreement of the Planning Authority:-
 - Design details of the proposed access road and its entry to the existing roundabout at Ballymount Road.
 This may require changing the angle of approach of the access road to the roundabout.
 - (b) Details of the proposed fencing on the eastern boundary of the site adjoining the proposed LRT

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>>> 3 Prior to the development commencing the applicant shall submit the following for the agreement of the Planning Authority:

- (a) A revised foul water drainage layout to provide for the construction by South Dublin County Council of a 225mm gravity sewer across the proposed cemetery from the neighbouring property to the north. The foul water drainage layout shall otherwise be provided as shown on drawing No. 9759/16.
- (b) Revised design calculations for the proposed surface water sewer to clarify an apparent discrepancy between the catchment area shown on Drawing No. 9759/12 and Council records. The surface water drainage layout shall otherwise be provided as shown on Drawing No. 9759/16.
- (c) Adequate provision shall be made to facilitate the South Dublin County Council to connect the water supply from the application site to the neighbouring site to the North-East to ensure continuity of supply. Final location of blank end to be agreed with Area Engineer, Deansrath Depot.

9 That no development under any permission granted pursuant to this decision be commenced until security for the provision and satisfactory completion of roads and services, has been given by lodgement with the Council of an approved Insurance Company Bond in the sum of £25,000.00 or lodgement with the Council of a cash sum of £25,000.00. REASON:

To ensure that a ready sanction may be available to induce the provision of services and prevent disamenity in the development.

(1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1991 amended 1994.



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- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. <u>A copy of the</u> <u>Commencement Notice is attached.</u>
