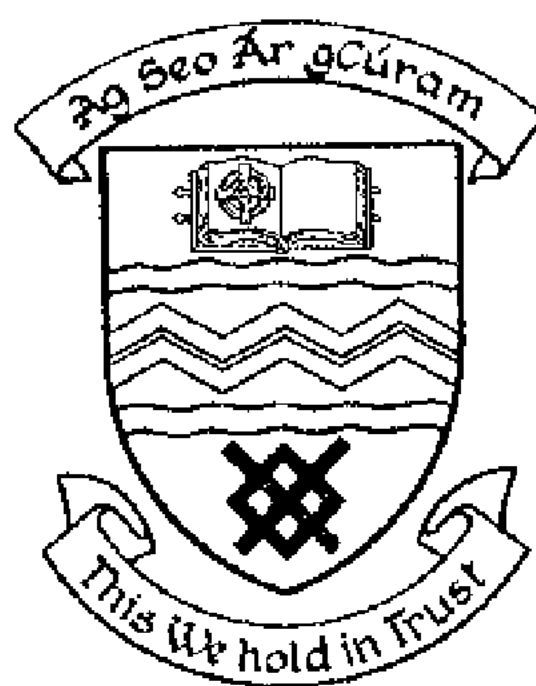

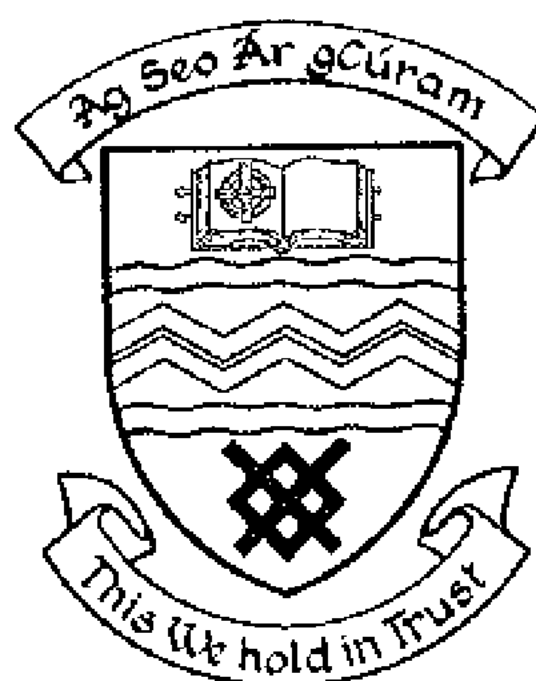

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Conditions and Reasons

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.  
REASON:  
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
  - 2 That the proposed railings and gates shall be painted dark green within three months of being erected and shall be maintained in a good state of repair and regularly painted in perpetuity.  
REASON:  
In the interest of visual amenity.
  - 3 No advertising signs, except those which constitute exempt development shall be erected without prior approval of the Planning Authority or An Bord Pleanála on appeal.  
REASON:  
In the interest of amenity.
- (1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1991 amended 1994.
  - (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
  - (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
  - (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.
