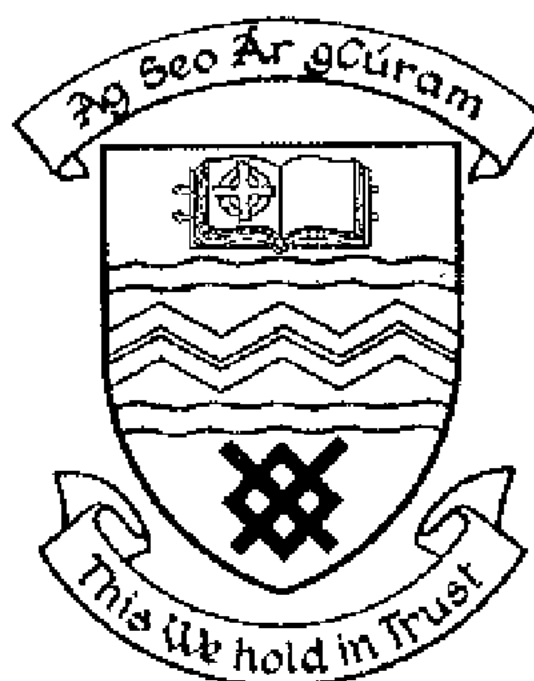

A Permission has been granted for the development described above,
subject to the following (14) conditions.

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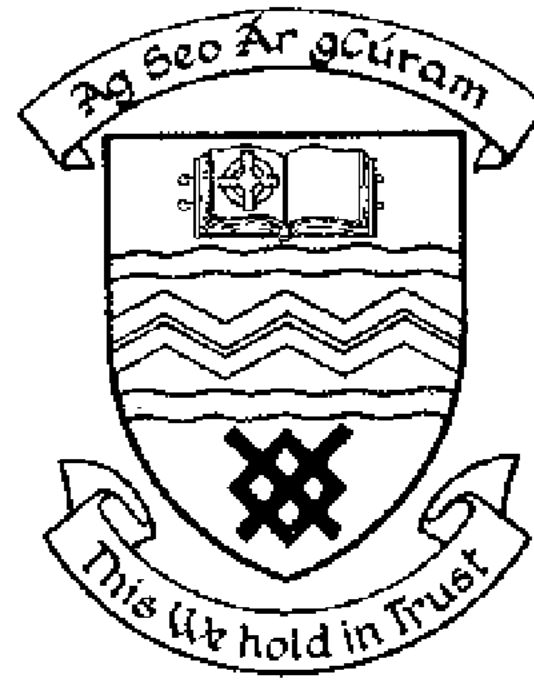
Conditions and Reasons

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application as amended by Additional Information received by the Planning Authority on 04/06/98, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
REASON:
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 That the proposed house be used as a single dwelling unit.
REASON:
To prevent unauthorised development.
- 3 That all public services to the proposed development, including electrical, telephone cables and equipment be located underground throughout the entire site.
REASON:
In the interest of amenity.
- 4 That no dwellinghouse be occupied until all the services have been connected thereto and are operational.
REASON:
In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
- 5 That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
REASON:
In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
- 6 That all watermain tapplings, branch connections, swabbing and chlorination be carried out by the County Council's, Environmental Services Department and that the cost thereof be paid to South Dublin County Council before any development commences.
REASON:
To comply with public health requirements and to ensure adequate standards of workmanship. As the provision of

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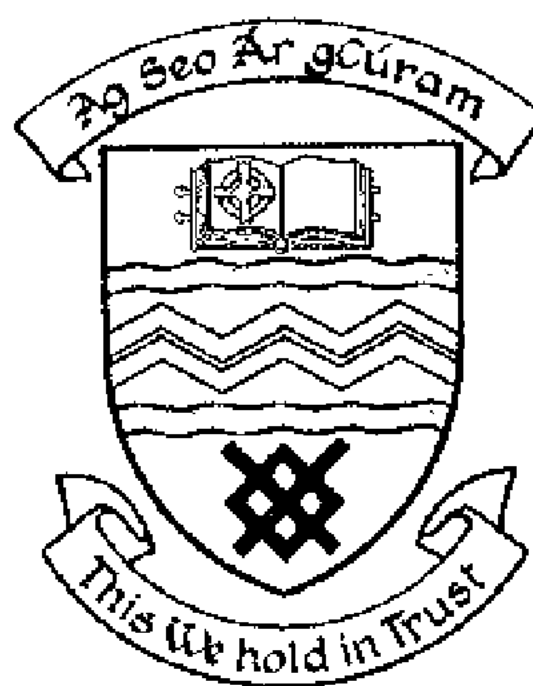
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these services by the County Council will facilitate the proposed development it is considered reasonable that the Council should recoup the cost.

- 7 That an acceptable house numbering scheme be submitted to and approved by the South Dublin County Council before any constructional work takes place on the proposed house.
REASON:
In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
- 8 The footpath and kerb shall be dishd to the requirements of the Area Engineer, Roads Maintenance Division, South Dublin County Council at the applicants expense.
REASON:
In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
- 9 The roof, windows and external walls of the proposed house shall match, as closely as possible, the external finishes of No. 11 Carriglea Rise.
REASON:
In the interest of architectural harmony and visual amenity.
- 10 Notwithstanding the exempted development provisions of the Planning Acts, 1963-1993, the proposed house shall not be extended to the rear except by a specific grant of planning permission from the Planning Authority or An Bord Pleanala on appeal.
REASON:
To safeguard the residential amenities of adjacent properties in the interest of the proper planning and development of the area as a large single storey extension is contained in this application to the rear of the house.
- 11 All first floor gable elevation windows shall be in permanent obscure glazing.
REASON:
In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

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- 12 That a financial contribution in the sum of money equivalent to the value of £800 (eight hundred pounds) as on 1st January, 1991, updated in accordance with the Wholesale Price Index - Building and Construction (Capital Goods) as published by the Central Statistics Office to the value pertaining at the time of payment shall be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of roads improvements and traffic management in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on road improvement works and traffic management schemes facilitating the proposed development.

- 13 That a financial contribution in the sum of £1,000 (one thousand pounds) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the provision and development of Class 1 public open space in the area of the proposed development and which will facilitate the development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on site.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on the provision and development of amenity lands in the area which will facilitate the proposed development.

- 14 That a financial contribution in the sum of £750 (seven hundred and fifty pounds) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

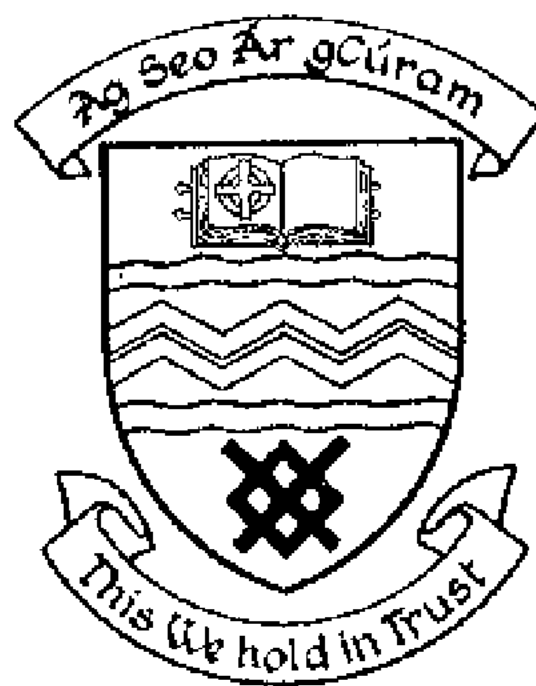
REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.

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- (1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1991 amended 1994.
- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
- (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
- (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.
