- That a financial contribution in the sum of £500.00 be paid by the proposer to the Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid on receipt of a grant of full planning permission.

### REASONS FOR CONDITIONS

- To prevent unauthorised development.
- To enable the effective of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed, having regard to the conditions then prevailing.
