#### Reasons

- The proposed development of a second house on this site unrelated to agricultural use or need would contravene materially a development objective of the 1993 Dublin county Development Plan for the use primarily of the site for agricultural purposes. The proposed development would result in haphazard one-off housing on agricultural lands which would injure the rural character of the area.
- The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to the generation of additional traffic turning movements at the proposed entrance where the vision splays available are deficient and at the junction of Ballymana Lane and Kiltipper Road where vision splays, particularly to the west, are deficient.
