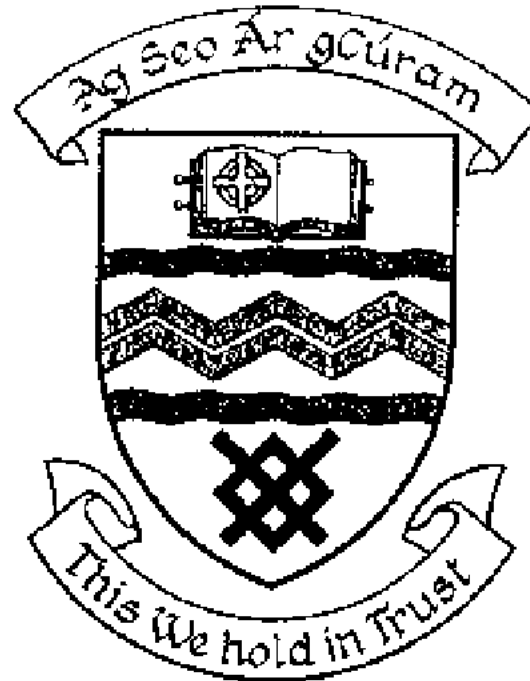

Dear Sir/Madam,

An inspection carried out on 26/08/97 has shown that a site notice was not erected in respect of your planning application. Before this application can be considered, you must erect a notice on the site or structure, and submit the following to the Department:

- (a) two copies of the text of the notice
- (b) two plans showing the position of the notice on the land or structure
- (c) a statement of the date on which the notice is erected

The notice must be maintained in position for at least one month and must fulfill the following conditions:-

1. Must be durable material
2. Must be securely erected in a conspicuous position easily visible and legible by persons using the public road
3. Must be headed "Application to Planning Authority".
4. Must state:
  - (a) Applicant's name
  - (b) whether application is for Permission, Outline Permission, or Approval.
  - (c) nature and extent of development including number of dwellings (if any)

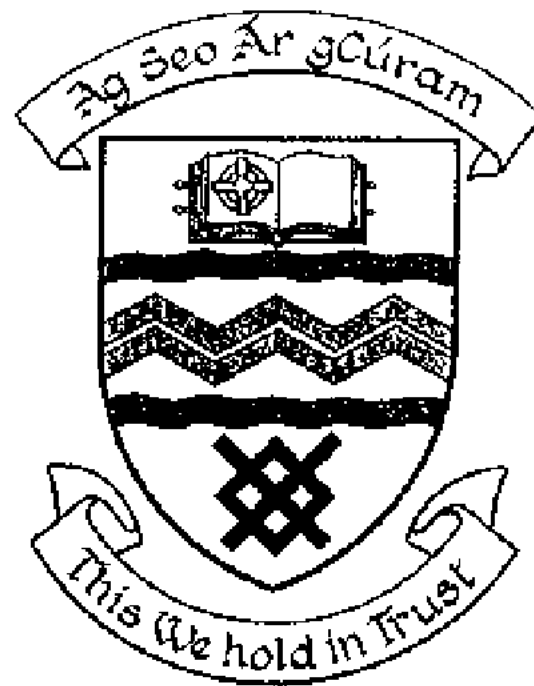
