

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Reasons

- The proposed development would reduce availability of onstreet parking and cause hazard to pedestrians. The proposed development would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development would be likely to result in the loss of a number of trees on the grass verge at the site frontage and would also result in the paving of a significant area of the front garden of the dwelling. The proposed development is therefore considered to be harmful to visual amenity and contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development would set an undesirable precedent for other similar developments which would in themselves and cumulatively endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard, be harmful to residential amenity and be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
