Reasons

- The wall by reason of its design, height, length and location is seriously injurious to the visual amenities of this rural area and is out-of-keeping with field and property boundaries in the vicinity. The development is contrary to Section 3.3.13(ii) of the 1993 Dublin County Development Plan which states 'inter alia' that "the traditional field pattern should be preserved and roadside and field boundary hedges retained or reinstated" and further that "recessed gateways should be constructed in local materials". The retention of the wall would contravene this Development Plan objective and, as such would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The existing wall copper fastens the inadequate visibility at the junction of Rathcoole Hill Road and Bolger's Lane and would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
