With reference to your planning application, received on 26/02/97 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning & Development) Acts 1963-1993, the following ADDITIONAL INFORMATION must be submitted in quadruplicate:

- It is noted that the proposed side extension is shown to be constructed on the party wall of an adjoining property. The applicant is requested to submit written agreement of the owners of the affected property or to submit amended plans so that no part of the proposed extension underpins or oversails the adjoining property including foundations, downpipes or gutters. In addition the proposed extension should be capable of being constructed without entering onto adjoining property.
- The proposed extension forward of the front and rear building lines would result in excessive lengths of gable wall facing in an easternly direction. The applicant is requested to submit amended plans to reduce the extent of the proposed gable wall of the property.

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- The submitted plans show a first floor bedroom window overlooking the adjoining properties to the east. Revised proposals omitting this window are required.

- The applicant is requested to confirm use of the proposed extension. In this regard confirmation as to the need for an additional internal stairway in the house is required.


