REASON:

To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

- 2 That the applicants indemnify the Local Authority against any claim made against the Authority as a result of the location of the bus shelter on public property.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

- 3 That the applicants make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the shelter.

REASON:

In the interest of visual amenity.

- 4 That the applicants accept responsibility for the removal of the bus shelter at their own expense, if such is necessary, for the purpose of road widening, reconstruction or repair, and for the repair, replacement and renewal of any services installed in the public street.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

- 5 The panels or shelter shall not be illuminated in such a manner so as to cause excessive glare or distraction to road users or adjoining property owners.

REASON:

In the interest of traffic safety and residential amenity.

- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
- (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
- (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.
