In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Acts the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order, P/ **A/779/83** dated **6/4/83** decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION~~ PERMISSION ~~APPROVAL~~

For **Proposed advertising panels at Castletymon Shopping Centre, Tallaght.**

for the following reasons:

1. The proliferation of both free standing and walls mounted advertising structures generally unrelated to the specific units contained within the neighbourhood centre and highly visible from the adjoining roads and adjoining areas would significantly detract from the appearance of the ~~neighbourhood~~ neighbourhood centre, be damaging to the residential amenities of the area and hence ~~be~~ contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
2. The large display signs 'C' and 'F' as per lodged plans, on the gable ends facing the distributor road would cause a serious distraction for motorists and thus endanger ~~the~~ public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
3. The proposed wall panel hoardings at locations 'C' and 'F' would by reason of their size, obtrusive appearance and position on purpose-designed brick-finished gable ends to the shops, not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.

NOTE: An appeal against the decision may be made to An Bord Pleanala by the applicant within one month from the date of receipt by the applicant of this notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and should be addressed to An Bord Pleanala, Irish Life Centre, Dublin 1, and accompanied by a deposit of £10. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn, An Bord Pleanala will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to them in the first instance.
