

The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.</p> <p>2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye Laws be obtained, and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.</p> <p>3. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.</p> <p>4. Boundary treatment and landscaping proposals plus specification to be submitted to and agreed with the Parks Department prior to commencement of any development works and shall then be fully implemented.</p> <p>5. Noise levels from within the site shall not exceed 50dB(A) rated sound level at any point along the boundary of the development between the houses 0800-1800 Monday to Friday inclusive, but excluding Bank Holidays. At all other times, including Bank Holidays, the noise level shall not exceed 35dB(A) rated sound level. For the purpose of determining compliance with the above, test procedures must be approved by the County Medical Officer before tests take place.</p>	<p>1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.</p> <p>2. In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.</p> <p>3. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.</p> <p>4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.</p> <p>5. In the interest of health and residential amenity.</p>
