The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission that effective control be maintained.
2. That before development commences, approval under the Building Bye-Laws be obtained and all conditions of that approval be observed in the development.	2. In order to comply with the Sanitation Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.
3. The external cladding of the station shall be local granite in order that it will harmonise as far as possible in colour and texture with the surrounding landscape so as to blend in with it and so as not to be visually obtrusive on such landscape.	3. In the interest of visual amenity.
4. The existing mast shall be dismantled and removed from the site upon completion of the new mast.	4. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
5. No boundary fencing or planting shall be undertaken without prior consultation and agreement with the Planning Authority.	5. In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.
6. That the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer shall be ascertained and all conditions stipulated shall be implemented in the development.	6. In the interest of safety and the avoidance of a fire hazard.
7. It will be necessary that the mast shall be marked and lighted for the guidance and protection of aircraft. If the sides of the mast are less than 5 ft (1.5m) in width, the mast should be painted orange in colour.	7. In the interest of safety.

7. Contd. Otherwise, it should be painted in alternate bands 5 ft (1.5m) deep of orange and white, the bands at the extremities of the mast being of orange. One aeronautical obstacle light fitting (preferably neon) showing not less than 10 candelas of fixed red light, visible from every direction, should be mounted at the top of the mast.
