WHEREAS on the 20th day of March, 1984, Greenhills Residents Association, care of 63, Saint Anthony's Crescent, Greenhills, Dublin, appealed to An Bord Pleanála against the decision made on the 1st day of March, 1984, by the Council of the County of Dublin to grant permission subject to conditions to Wren Property Company Limited of 24, Terenure Road, East, Dublin for alteration to elevations of three new factory units and the sub-division of an existing factory unit at Greenhills Industrial Estate, Dublin:
