

That the proposed mast be structurally stable and that applicant make satisfactory arrangements for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the structure. 4. That the external appearance of the proposed radio link station harmonise in colour and texture with the adjoining landscape and that any additional landscaping required for the purpose of ensuring the preservation of amenity be provided.	1. To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.  2. To enable the effect of the development on the amenities of the area to be reviewed having regard to the conditions then obtaining. 3. In the interest of safety and the proper planning and development.  4. In the interest of visual amenity.
