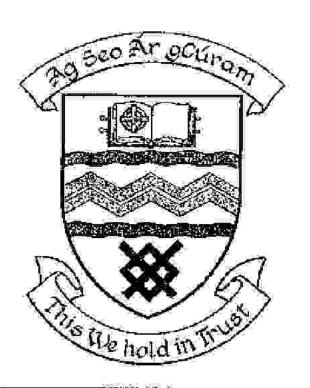

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Conditions and Reasons

- The development in its entirety to be in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application and Unsolicited Additional Information received by the Planning Authority on 07/03/02, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

 REASON:
 - To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission, and that effective control be maintained.
- That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council. The proposed development shall adhere to the following:-
 - (a) Applicant to ensure full and complete separation of foul and surface water systems.
 - (b) All surface water runoff from the development shall be routed via an adequate silt trap and petrol/oil/diesel interceptor before discharging to the surface water sewer. Petrol/oil/diesel interceptor to meet the requirements of BS 8301:1985.
 - (c) All liquid storage areas shall be contained within a watertight bund structure, capable of containing at least 110% of the volume of the largest drum / tank within the bund.
 - (d) No discharge of trade effluent to sewer shall be permitted without the applicant first obtaining from the Environmental Services Department, a licence under section 16 of the Water Pollution Acts 1977-1990.
 - (e) Applicant to ensure full and complete separation of foul and surface water systems.
 - All pipes shall be laid with a minimum cover of 1.2m in roads, footpaths and driveways, and 0.9m in open space. Where it is not possible to achieve these minimum covers, pipes shall be bedded and surrounded in C20 concrete 150mm thick.
 - (g) If not already the case any water supply to the development shall be commercially metered. Full 24 hour water storage shall be provided

REASON:

In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.

The structures the subject of this permission shall be removed on or before the 1st April, 2005 unless before that date permission for their retention is granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanala on appeal. REASON:

The site is severely affected by the Naas Motorway reservation and the vehicular entrance to the site would be located within the road reservation set back".

That prior to commencement of development the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

REASON:

In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.

The applicant shall submit details of landscaping and boundary treatment to be agreed, by the Planning Authority which shall screen adjacent residential property from odours, noise and visual intrusion generated by the operation of the proposed development.

That a financial contribution in the sum of EUR 1,355 (one thousand three hundred and fifty five euro) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid on receipt of final grant of permission.

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.

7 That a financial contribution in the sum of money equivalent to the value of EUR 3,526 (three thousand five hundred and twenty six euro) towards the cost of roads improvements and Page 3 of 4

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traffic management in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid on receipt of final grant of permission.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on road improvement works and traffic management schemes facilitating the proposed development.

That a financial contribution in the sum of EUR 196 (one hundred and ninety six euro) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the "9B" Catchment foul drainage improvement works which will facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid on receipt of final grant of permission.

REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of the works.
