## Reasons

- The proposed dwelling, by virtue of its position vis-a-vis the perpendicular row of houses to the north, would break the front building line of the latter houses. It would also result in an unacceptable level of overlooking which would seriously injure the amenities of property in the vicinity, For these reasons, the proposal would contravene materially the zoning objective for the area as set out in the South Dublin County Development Plan, 1998, which is 'to protect and/or improve residential amenity'.
- The proposed development, by virtue of its proximity to a 375mm public foul sewer, would be prejudicial to public health. Due to the size of the sewer and its depth of over 4m, a minimum distance of 5 metres is required in this instance between the sewer and any proposed development.
