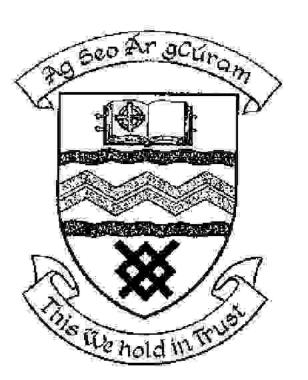
Reasons

- The proposed development is premature pending the adoption of the Local Area Plan for Al zoned lands at Rathcoole, including the application site.
- The proposed access to the site via an existing laneway that is substandard in width and construction, has no footpaths, drainage or public lighting, and forms an unsafe junction with the Kilteel Road, would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.
- Council standards require a minimum setback of 30m between residential units and boundary fence of the Naas Road but site layout plan shows only a 20m setback.
- The proposed layout of the development is unacceptable because of its proximity to the existing public 225mm diameter foul sewer in the adjoining field. It is a requirement of the Environmental Services Department that no buildings be located within 5m of a public foul sewer of this size. The proposed development would therefore be prejudicial to public health.
- The proposed development is premature pending the implementation of the recommendations of the consultant's report into the existing foul sewer network in Saggart, and pending the implementation of the Boherboy Water Supply Scheme. The proposed development would therefore be prejudicial to public health.
- Insufficient details have been submitted to show how the applicant proposes to deal with the surface water run-off from the development. The proposed development would therefore be prejudicial to public health.
- The public notices submitted do not refer to demolition of the bungalow, a habitable dwelling, as required in accordance with the relevant sections of the Local Government (Planning and Development) Regulations, 1994, and the application is therefore deficient in this regard.
