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Conditions and Reasons

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
REASON:
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 That the proposed house be used as a single dwelling unit only.
REASON:
To prevent unauthorised development.
- 3 That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works.
REASON:
To protect the amenities of the area.
- 4 That all public services to the proposed development, including electrical, telephone cables and equipment be located underground throughout the entire site.
REASON:
In the interest of amenity.
- 5 That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
REASON:
In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
- 6 Before development commences, the applicant shall submit for agreement by the Planning Authority a detailed method statement for the construction of the house, which shows full details of how it is proposed to protect the nearby

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public watermain from damage. This shall include constructing the foundations below the invert level of the watermain.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

7 The following requirements of the Roads Department are to be satisfied:

- (a) Footpath and kerb to be dished and the new driveway constructed to the satisfaction of the Area Engineer, Roads Maintenance.
- (b) The gradient of the access shall not exceed 2.5% over the last 6 metres of approach to the public road.
- (c) The relocation of the street tree to be at the applicant's own expense.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

8 That an acceptable house numbering scheme be submitted to and agreed by the Planning Authority before development commences.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

9 That all external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing premises.

REASON:

In the interest of visual amenity.

10 That a financial contribution in the sum of £750 (seven hundred and fifty pounds) EUR 952 (nine hundred and fifty euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered

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reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.

- 11 That a financial contribution in the sum of £2,100 (two thousand one hundred pounds) EUR 2,666 (two thousand six hundred and sixty six euros) shall be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of roads improvements and traffic management in the area of the proposed development and which facilitates this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on road improvement works and traffic management schemes facilitating the proposed development.

- 12 That a financial contribution in the sum of £1,000 (one thousand pounds) EUR 1,270 (one thousand two hundred and seventy euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the development and improvement of public open space in the area of the proposed development and which will facilitate the development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on site.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on the development and improvement of amenity lands in the area which will facilitate the proposed development.

- 13 That a financial contribution in the sum of £400 (four hundred pounds) EUR 507 (five hundred and seven euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the Lucan/Palmerstown Water Supply Improvement Scheme which serves this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on site.

REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered

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reasonable that the development should contribute towards the cost of the works.

- 14 That a financial contribution in the sum of £100 (one hundred pounds) EUR 127 (one hundred and twenty seven euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the upgrading of Esker Pumping Station; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.

NOTE:

The applicant's attention is drawn to Section 26 (11) of the 1963 Local Government (Planning and Development) Act, 1963 which states that "a person shall not be entitled solely by reason of a permission or approval under this section to carry out any development".
