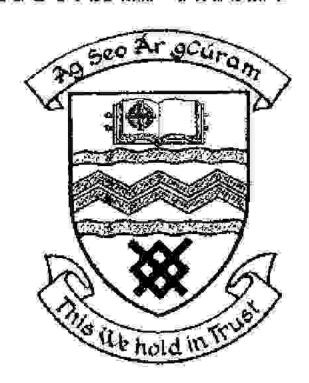

- It is considered that the proposal is visually unacceptable in terms of height and design. The applicant is requested to submit revised drawings for the proposed dwelling reducing the overall height and simplifying the front façade to comply with Appendix D of the 1998 South Dublin County Development Plan, "Guidelines on the Siting and Design of Rural Dwellings". The applicant is advised that simpler fenestration would be preferable in this instance.
