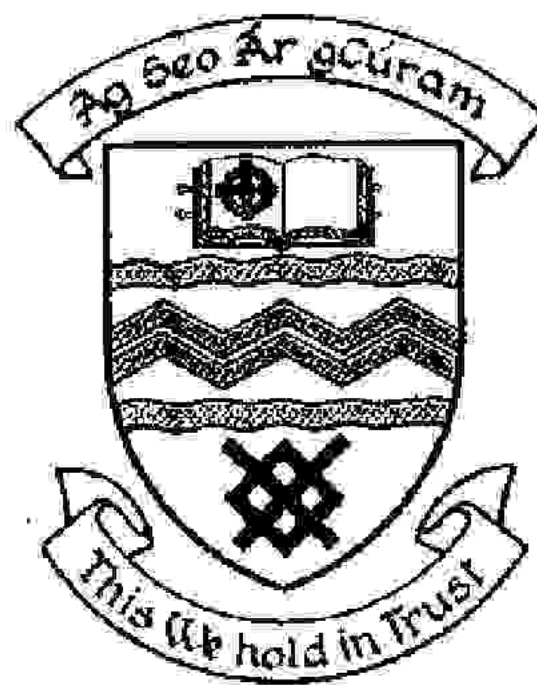

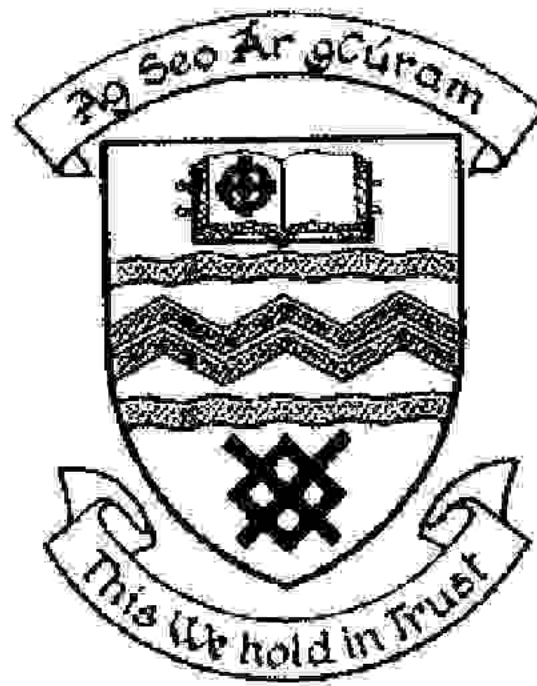

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Conditions and Reasons

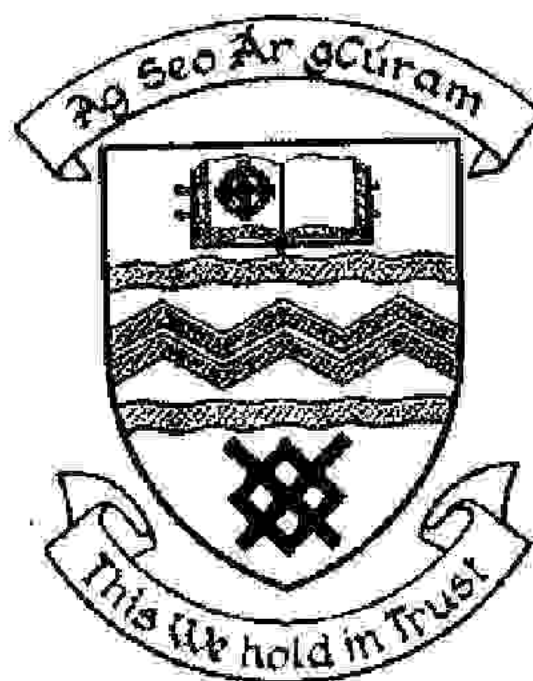
- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
REASON:
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works.
REASON:
To protect the amenities of the area.
- 3 That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
REASON:
In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
- 4 That details of landscaping and boundary treatment be submitted to and approved by the Planning Authority and work thereon completed prior to occupation of dwelling.
REASON:
In the interest of amenity.
- 5 That the entire premises be used as a single dwelling unit.
REASON:
To prevent unauthorised development.
- 6 That all external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing premises.
REASON:
In the interest of visual amenity.
- 7 The following requirements of the Planning Authority shall be adhered to:
 - (i) Parking provision for the existing and proposed house shall be as per the submitted plans.
 - (ii) The footpath and kerb shall be dished and the new driveway constructed for the existing house to the satisfaction of the Area Engineer, Roads Maintenance.
 - (iii) The relocation/replacement of the tree and lamp

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standard (if necessary) shall be at applicant's own expense.

(iv) The footpath and kerb shall be dished and the new driveway constructed for the proposed house to the satisfaction of the Area Engineer, Roads Maintenance.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

8 The applicant shall adhere to the following requirements of the Environmental Services Department:-

(i) No buildings shall be erected within 5 metres of a public sewer or any sewer with the potential to be taken in charge.

(ii) The applicant shall ensure full and complete separation of foul and surface water systems.

(iii) All pipes shall be laid with a minimum cover of 1.2m in roads, footpaths and driveways, and 0.9m in open space. Where it is not possible to achieve these minimum covers, pipes shall be bedded and surrounded in C20 concrete 150mm thick.

(iv) As a 100mm diameter public watermain is within 5m (approx. 3m) of the proposed house prior to the commencement of development the applicant shall submit a detailed method statement for the construction of the house including full details of how it is proposed to protect the watermain from damage. These shall include constructing the foundations beneath the invert level of the watermain.

(v) The property shall have its own individual service connection to the public watermain and 24hour storage.

(vi) The connection to and tapping of public watermains shall be carried out by South Dublin County Council personnel at the applicant's prior expense.

REASON:

In the interest of public health and the proper planning and development of the area.

9 That an acceptable name/house number be submitted and approved by the County Council before any constructional work has taken place on the proposed house.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

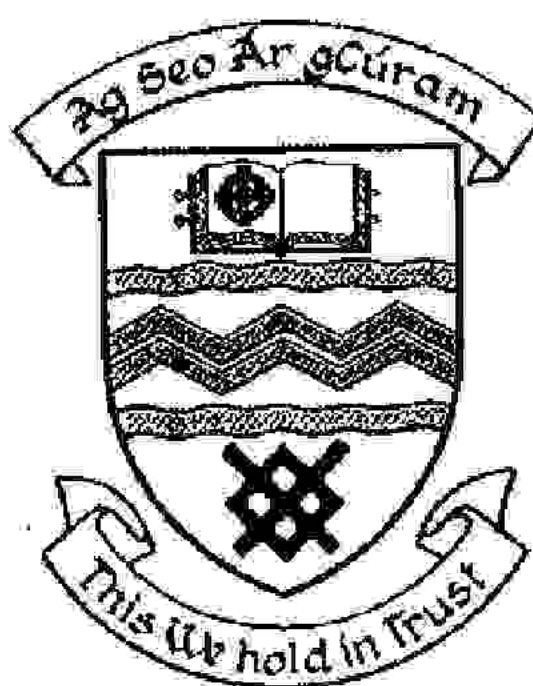
10 That a financial contribution in the sum of £750 (seven hundred and fifty pounds) EUR 952 (nine hundred and fifty two euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of provision of public services in

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the area of the proposed development and which facilitate this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.

- 11 That a financial contribution in the sum of £2,100 (two thousand one hundred pounds) EUR 2,666 (two thousand six hundred and sixty six euros) shall be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of roads improvements and traffic management in the area of the proposed development and which facilitates this development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on the site.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on road improvement works and traffic management schemes facilitating the proposed development.

- 12 That a financial contribution in the sum of £1,000 (one thousand pounds) EUR 1,270 (one thousand two hundred and seventy euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the development and improvement of public open space in the area of the proposed development and which will facilitate the development; this contribution to be paid before the commencement of development on site.

REASON:

It is considered reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the expenditure that was incurred and/or that is proposed to be incurred by the Council on the development and improvement of amenity lands in the area which will facilitate the proposed development.

- 13 That a financial contribution in the sum of £1,143 (one thousand one hundred and forty three pounds) EUR 1,451 (one thousand four hundred and fifty one euros) be paid by the proposer to South Dublin County Council towards the cost of the Dodder Valley Catchment Drainage Improvement Works which serves this development.

REASON:

The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered

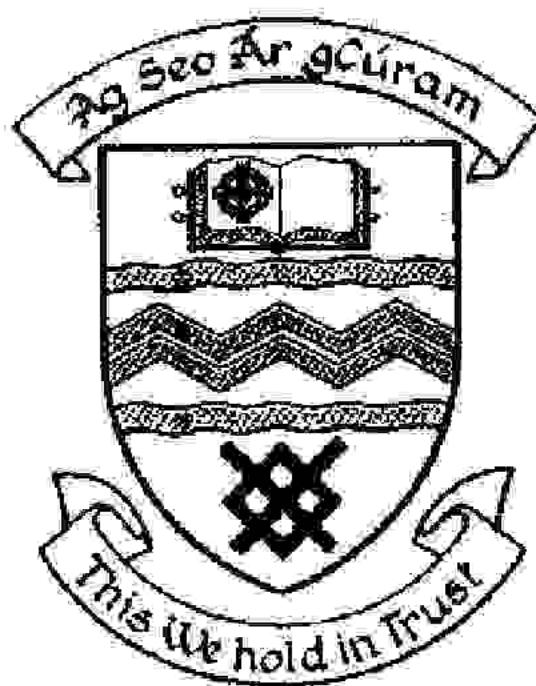

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reasonable that the developer should contribute towards the cost of the works.

- (1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1997.
- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
- (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
- (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.
