## Reasons

- It is the policy of the Council (Policy R3 South Dublin County Development Plan 1998) to conserve the existing housing stock of the county wherever possible and to protect and improve residential amenities in existing residential areas. It is considered that the proposed development would seriously prejudice the continuence in residential use of the neighbouring houses in the terrace by the precedent which a grant of permission for it would set for similar changes of use. It would therefore be contrary to the policy of the Planning Authority to conserve the existing housing stock.
- It is considered that the proposed development, by its nonresidential nature and increased intensity of site use,
  would seriously detract from the existing amenities,
  character and heritage of the site and of the designated
  Conservation Area at Lucan Village, and would conflict with
  the need to conserve the existing residential accommodation
  within the Conservation Area in accordance with Policy H2
  South Dublin County Development Plan 1998. It would
  therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development
  of the area.
