## Reasons

- The proposed development is located in a mountain an area of outstanding natural character as set out in the South Dublin County Development Plan 1998. Within such areas dwellings will only be permitted where
  - The applicant is a native of the area and
  - The applicant can demonstrate a genuine need for housing in that particular area and
  - The development is related directly to the area's amenity potential or to its use for agriculture, mountain or hill farming and
  - The development would not prejudice the environmental capacity of the area, and that be in keeping with the character of the mountain area.

The proposed development does not comply with the above criteria and the development would therefore be contrary to the provisions of the County Development Plan and the proper planning and development of the area.

- It is considered that the proposed house, by virtue of its height, bulk and poor design characteristics would be visually obtrusive in and out of character with this area of outstanding natural character and would accordingly, be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The generation of additional traffic/turning movements at a location where visibility splays are substandard at the site entrance would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard and would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
