- The proposed development contravenes materially a development objective indicated in the Dublin County Development Plan for the use solely or primarily of particular areas for particular purposes i.e. zoning objective 'B' To protect and improve rural amenity and to provide for the development of agriculture. The proposed development would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and obstruction of road users.due to the increase in turning movements which the development generates on the National Primary Route N7 and the substandard nature of Colemanstown Lane,
