CONDITIONS:-

- (1) The development to be carried out in strict conformity with the plans and specifications to which this permission relates. Approval under the Building Bye-laws to be obtained and all conditions of approval to be observed in the development. (To achieve a satisfactory standard of construction and to prevent unauthorized development)
- (2) A boundary fence of substantial construction 18" high must be erected along the entire frontage of the site except at new "crossover" and existing crossover near the north eastern boundary of the site. (To prevent the creation of a hazard to pedestrians and traffic).

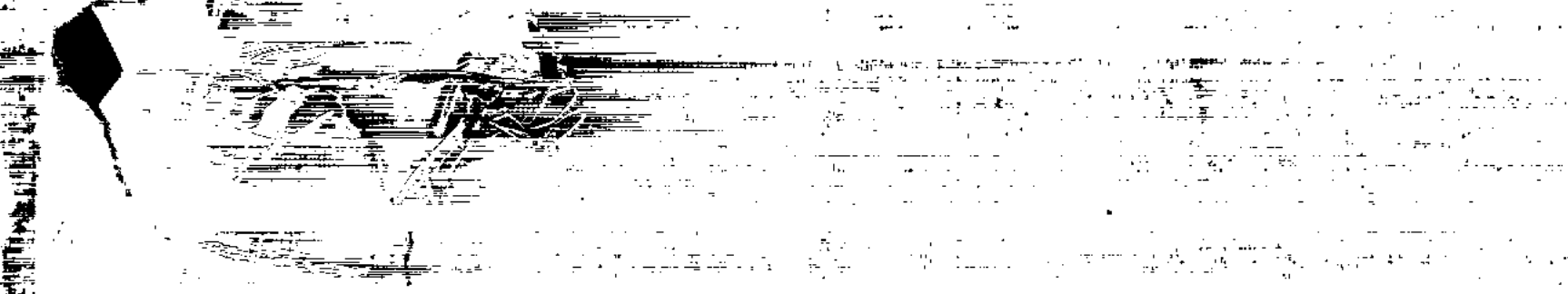

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin
 County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District
 of Dublin, did by order 17/107/65. dated 2.7.65. make a
 decision pursuant to Section 26 (1) of the Act to grant a permission for:

Extension to 8 Dalbrissan Rd. Leeson.

subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) That the external finish harmonise with the existing house.



If there is no appeal to the Minister for Local Government against this
 decision, permission will be granted by the Council on the expiration of
 the period for the taking of such appeal. If every appeal made in
 accordance with the Act has been withdrawn, the Council will grant the
 permission as soon as may be after the withdrawal.

 notification or by any other person within twenty-one days of the date of the
 decision. The appeal shall be in writing and shall state the subject matter
 of the appeal and grounds of the appeal and the nature of the appellant's
 interest in the property affected and should be addressed to the Secretary,
 Department of Local Government, (Planning Appeals Section) Custom
 House Quay, Dublin 1. When an appeal has been duly made and has not been
 withdrawn, the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for
 permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
