

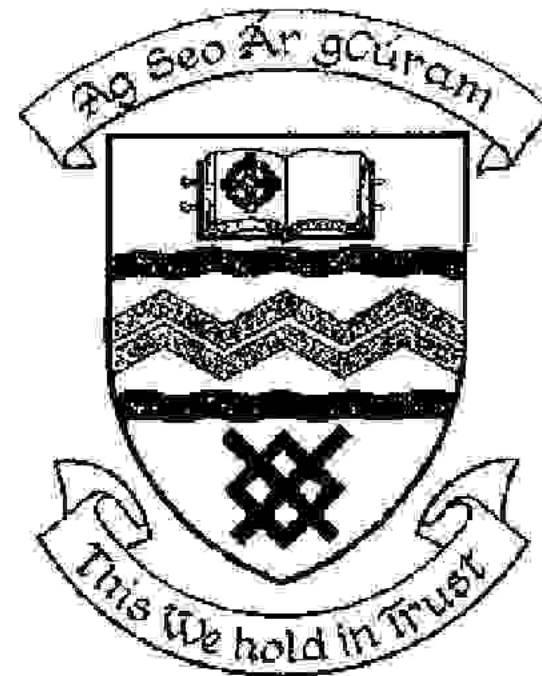

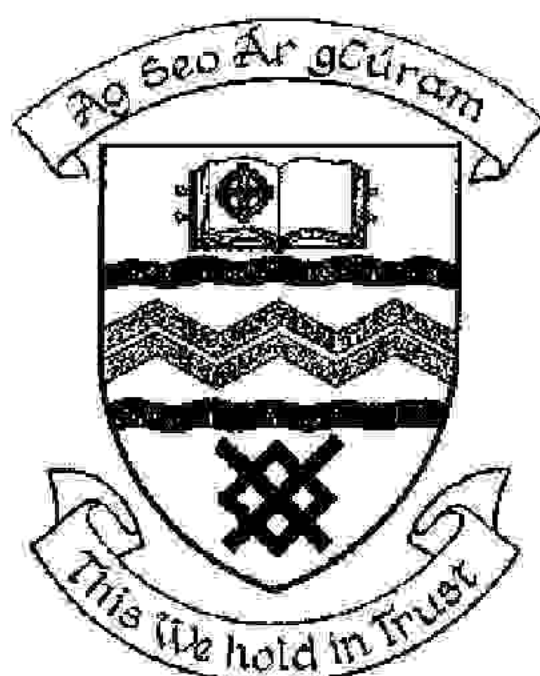

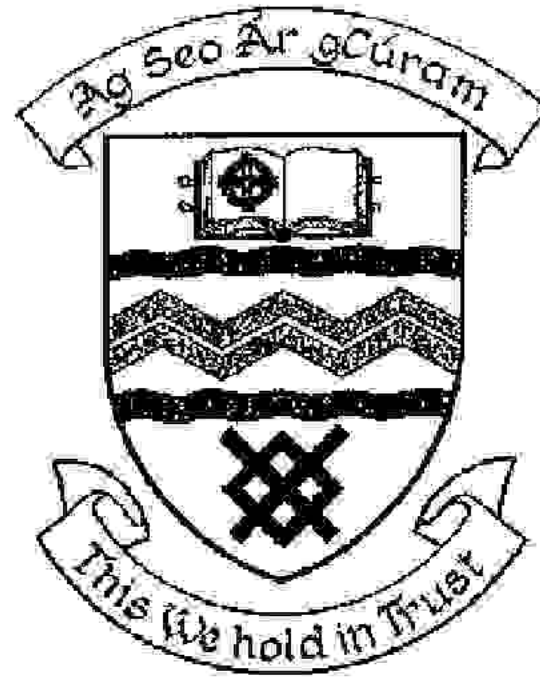
Conditions and Reasons

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
REASON:
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works.
REASON:
To protect the amenities of the area.
- 3 The applicant's layout and block plan show the surface water from the proposed prefab draining to a "sump". This is unacceptable as there are surface water sewers in the area. In this regard the applicant shall submit revised drainage plans showing the exact location of all drains, manholes, gullies, AJs etc., up to the point of connection to the sewer. This layout shall be in accordance with the Building Regulations and shall ensure full and complete separation of foul and surface water systems. The applicant shall note that no buildings shall be erected within 5 metres of a public sewer or any sewer with the potential to be taken in charge.

In the interests of public health.
- 4 The applicant is requested to submit a Parking Layout Plan to South Dublin Development Plan 1998 standards (i.e. one space per classroom) prior to the commencement of development.
