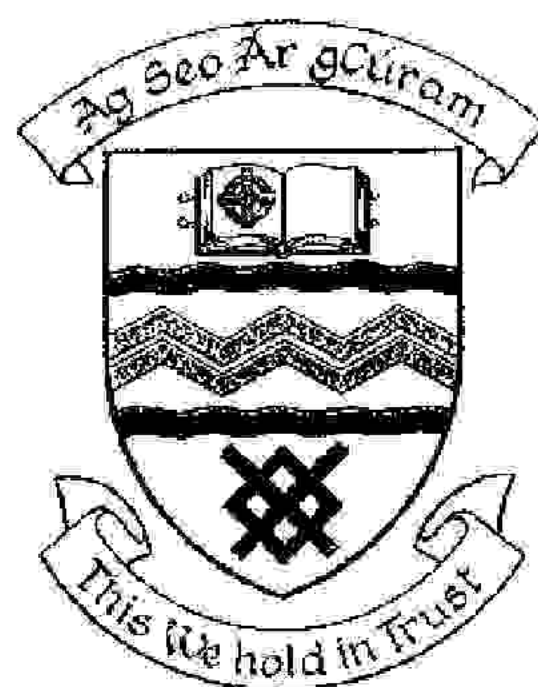

With reference to your planning application, received on 20/04/01 in connection with the above, I wish to inform you that before the application can be considered under the Local Government (Planning & Development) Acts 1963-1999 and the Planning and Development Act 2000, the following **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION** must be submitted in quadruplicate:

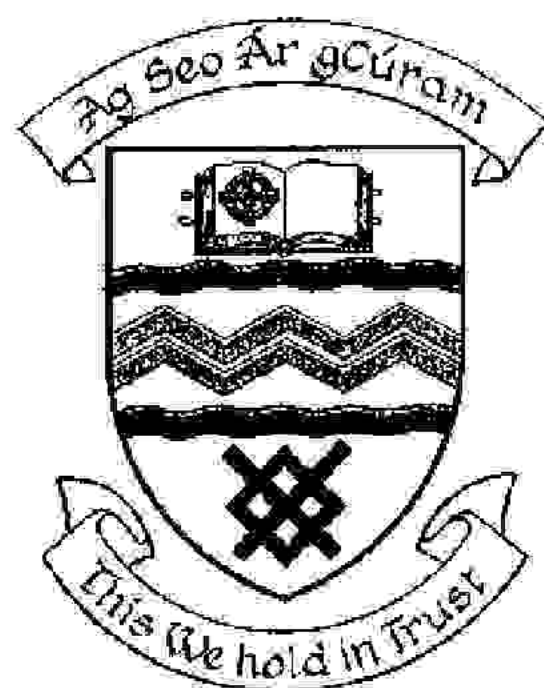
- 1 The removal of the existing brise soleil from only a portion of the south-eastern facade of St. John's House is unlikely to be acceptable to the Planning Authority. The applicants are requested to amend the application to include the removal of the brise soleil from the full length of St. John's House and to submit, in quadruplicate, revised drawings, site maps, etc. as appropriate. The applicant should also submit amended public notices (site and newspaper notices) and amended application form to include the removal of the brise soleil from the full length of St. John's House, in accordance with the Local Government (Planning and Development) Regulations, 1994.
- 2 The removal of the brise soleil from the facade of St. John's House is likely to result in an unsatisfactory and unfinished appearance to the building (note north-east elevation). The applicant is requested to provide, in quadruplicate, drawings showing an appropriate treatment of

the entire facade (including that of the north-east
elavation) following the removal of the brise soleil. The
applicant should note that the public notices and
application form should be amended if necessary.

- 3 The applicants are requested to clarify why they find it
necessary to remove the brise soleil.
