

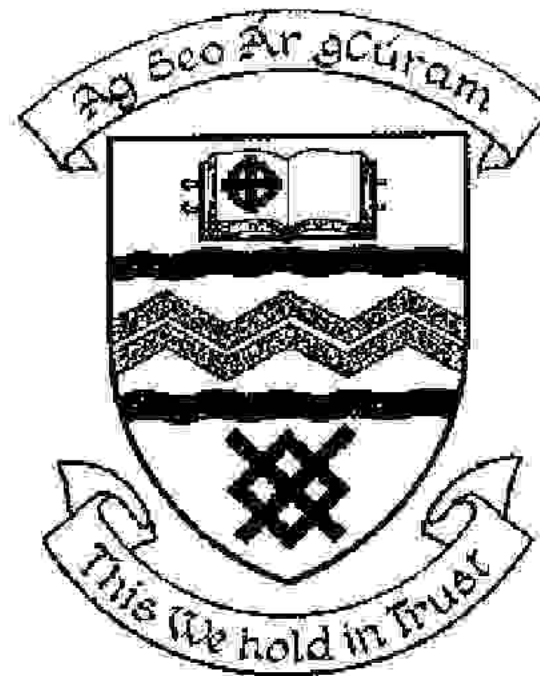

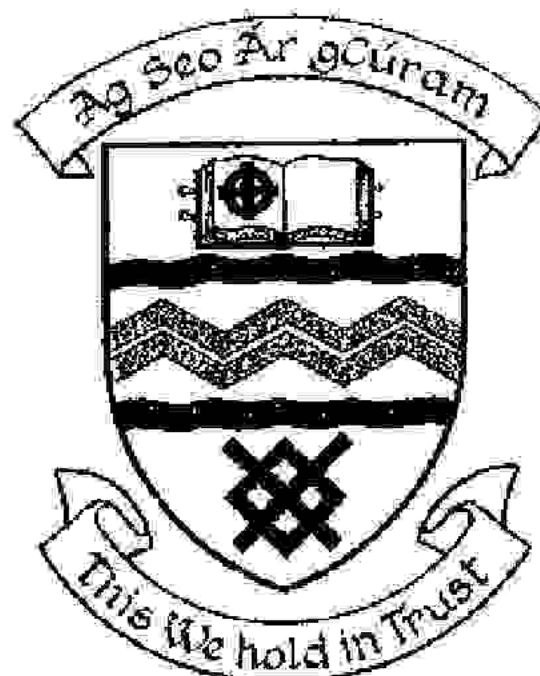

**Conditions and Reasons**

- 1 The development to be retained in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

**REASON:**

To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

- 2 That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the South Dublin County Council.

**REASON:**

In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 - 1964.

- 3 That prior to commencement of development the requirements of the Principal Environmental Health Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

**REASON:**

In the interest of health.

- 4 No additional advertising signs or devices shall be painted or affixed to the premises without first receiving a separate planning permission from South Dublin County Council, whether or not such advertising signs or devices might otherwise constitute exempted development.

**REASON:**

In the interests of the control of advertising with respect to the visual amenities of the area.
