Reasons

- 1 It is considered that the proposed development of apartments would constitute overdevelopment of a restricted site, would be substandard in terms of residential amenity, private open space and the provision of car parking. It would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
- 2 Having regard to the existing and proposed development and the serious shortfall in the provision of car parking in this area relative to the requirements of the South Dublin County Council Development Plan (1998), it is considered that the proposed development would result in additional onstreet car parking on a heavily trafficked local road network, which would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and the obstruction of road users.

It is considered that the proposed development is excessive 1 in terms of bulk and height and would result in unacceptable overlooking of adjoining properties.

(ii) showing the proposed two storey side extension set back at least 0.5m from the main front building line of the house, and the roof thereof set down and set back from the main roof.
