

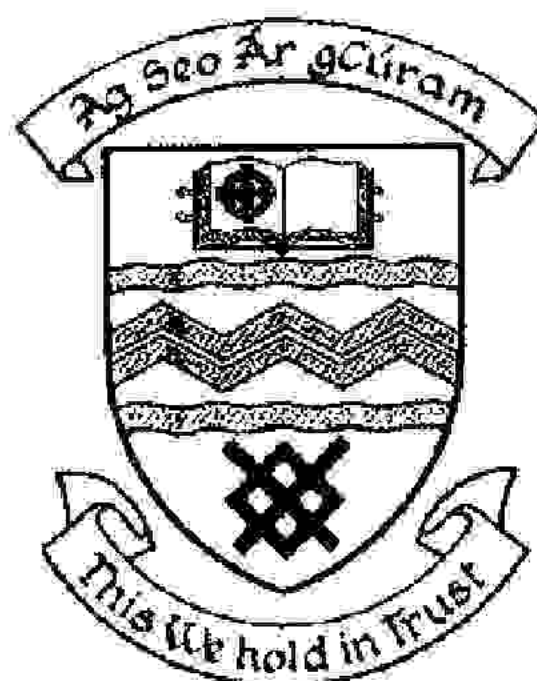

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Conditions and Reasons

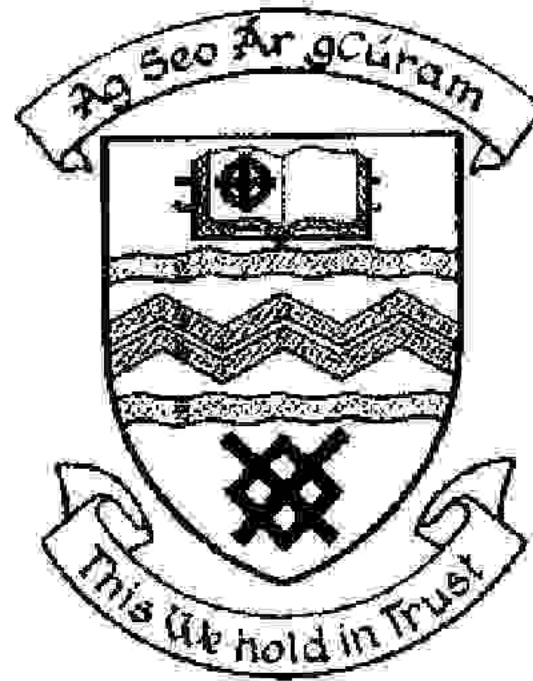
- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, and additional information received 14/05/2001 save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
REASON:
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 Prior to the commencement of works on site, details should be provided of the proposed wall and railing along the boundaries of the site (as per condition no.2 of Planning Permission Reg.Ref. S01A/0069).
REASON:
In the interests of visual amenity.
- 3 The following requirements of the Environmental Services Department shall be satisfied.
 - (i) No building shall be erected within 5 metres of a public sewer or any sewer with the potential to be taken in charge.
 - (ii) The applicant shall ensure full and complete separation of foul and surface water systems.
 - (iii) All pipes shall be laid with a minimum cover of 1.2m in roads, footpaths and driveways, and 0.9m in open space. Where it is not possible to achieve these minimum covers, pipes shall be bedded and surrounded in C20 concrete 150mm thick.
 - (iv) The development shall have its own service connection to the public watermain and 24hour storage.
 - (v) If not already the case the water supply to the school shall be commercially metered.
 - (vi) The new watermain shall be looped to facilitate self-cleaning rather than terminating in a duckfoot hydrant.
 - (vii) The connection to and tapping of public watermains shall be carried out by South Dublin County Council personnel at the applicant's prior expense.REASON:
In the interests of public health.
- 4 That prior to commencement of development the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.
REASON:
In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.

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- 5 That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works.

- 6 That prior to the commencement of the development the requirements of the Supervising Environmental Health Officer be ascertained and the strictly adhered to in the development.

REASON:

In the interest of health.

- (1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1997.
- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
- (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
- (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.

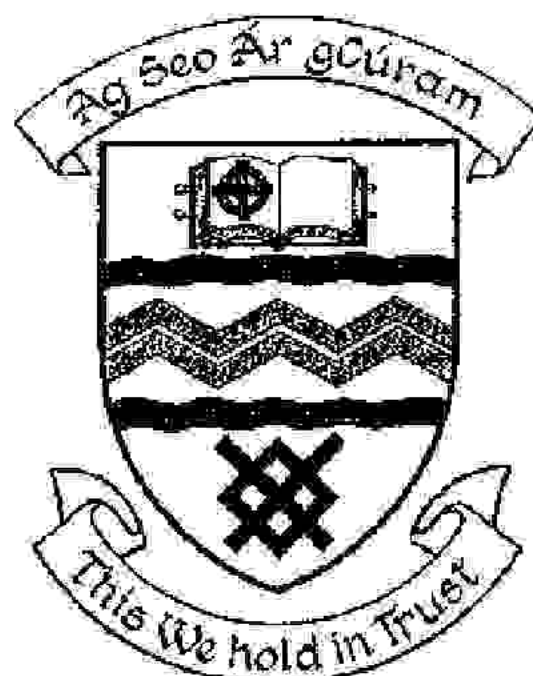

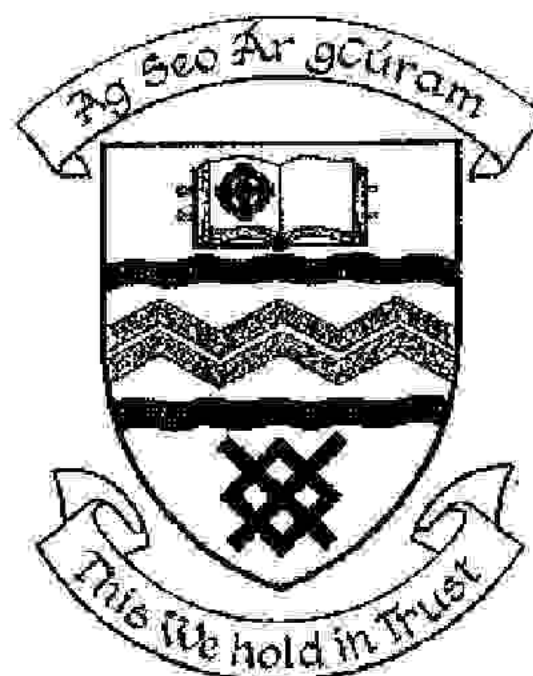
