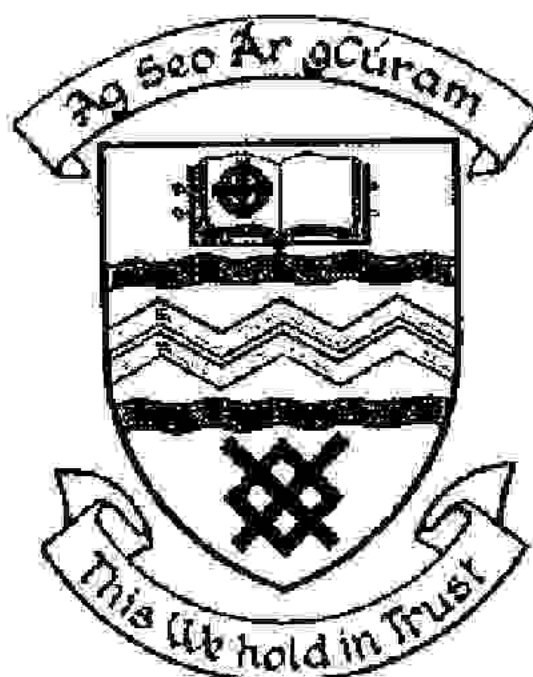

A Permission has been granted for the development described above,
subject to the following (7) Conditions.

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Conditions and Reasons

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.
REASON:
To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.
- 2 The structure shall be removed on the expiration of the period of 5 years beginning on the date of the grant of permission, unless planning permission for its retention is first granted by the Planning Authority or by An Bord Pleanála on appeal.
REASON:
A structure of this type is not acceptable for use as a classroom on a permanent basis.
- 3 The applicant proposes (drawing no. M145-B/SK01) to connect toilets to a surface water manhole. This is unacceptable. The applicant shall submit revised and complete details of proposed drainage up to and including connection to public sewer for both foul and surface water drainage. Details to indicate that only rainwater will be discharged to the surface water drainage system.
REASON:
To ensure a satisfactory standard of development.
- 4 The applicant shall submit within one month of the date of grant of permission for the written approval of the Environmental Services Department, details of the position of the nearest fire hydrant.
REASON:
In the interest of fire safety and the proper planning and development of the area.
- 5 That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the County Council.
REASON:
In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878-1964.
- 6 That prior to commencement of development the requirements of the Chief Fire Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

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REASON:

In the interest of safety and the avoidance of fire hazard.

- 7 That prior to commencement of development the requirements of the Principal Environmental Health Officer be ascertained and strictly adhered to in the development.

REASON:

In the interest of health.

- (1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1997.
- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
- (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
- (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.

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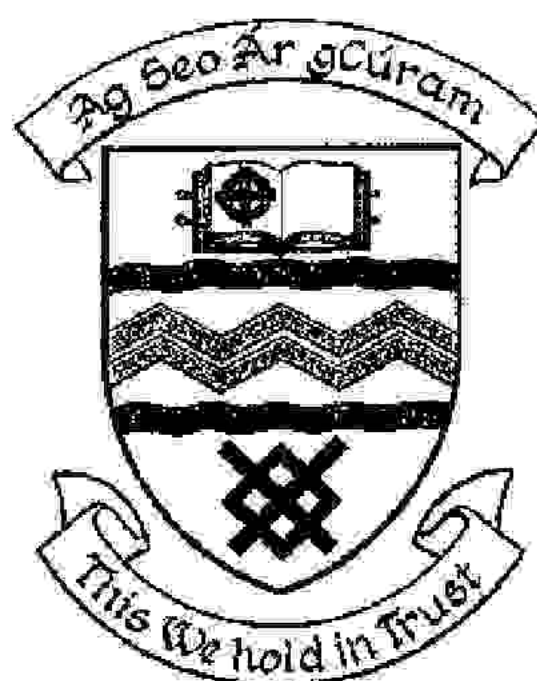
