DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1999, it is hereby decided, for the reason set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the retention of the said illuminated sign at front and sign painted on double gates in accordance with the said plans and particulars and the said permission is hereby granted. Furthermore, permission is hereby refused for the retention of the said illuminated sign at the side of the building for the reason set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

It is considered that the signs to be retained at the front of the premises would not seriously injure the amenities of the area and would not be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.



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SECOND SCHEDULE

It is considered that the side elevation sign, by reason of its size, location to the side of the premises and internal illumination, would seriously injure the amenities of the area and would be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
