Reasons

The site is located in an area subject to the zoning objective 'H' "to protect and enhance the outstanding natural character of the Dublin Mountain Area" in the 1998 South Dublin County Development Plan. Section 2.3.1(iii) of the South Dublin County Development Plan 1998 states the following: "Within areas designated Zoning Objective 'H' ("to protect and enhance the outstanding natural character of the Dublin Mountain area") dwellings will only be permitted where:

the applicant is a native of the area and,
the applicant can demonstrate a genuine need for
housing in that particular area and,
the development is related directly to the area's
amenity potential or to its use for agriculture,
mountain or hill farming and,
the development would not prejudice the
environmental capacity of the area and that it be in
keeping with the character of the mountain area".

The Planning Authority is not satisfied that the proposed development fulfills all of the above requirements. The proposed development would, therefore, contravene materially the said zoning objective and would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area.

- The proposed development, by virtue of its siting on a slightly elevated slope and of its design, would be visually obtrusive and as such would conflict with Zoning Objective 'H'.
- The proposed development would interfere with views for which it is an objective to preserve in the South Dublin County Development Plan 1998.
- The proposed development would constitute undesirable ribbon development on a substandard rural road network, which will lead to a demand for the uneconomic provision of services and would set an undesirable precedent for further similar developments in the area. It would therefore be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
