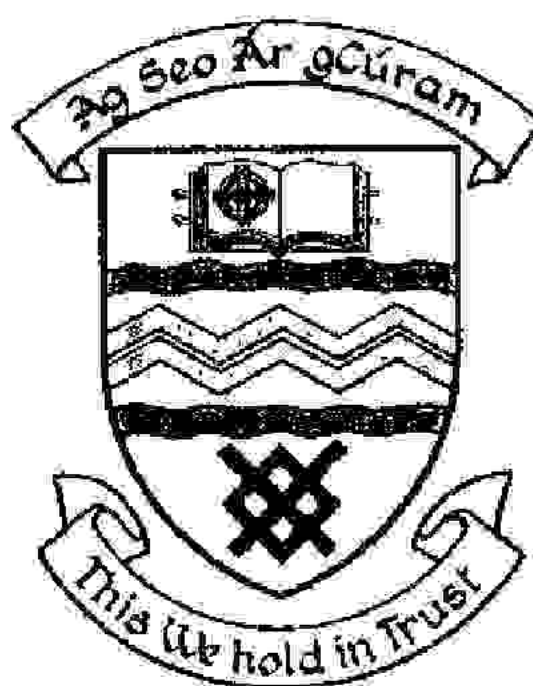

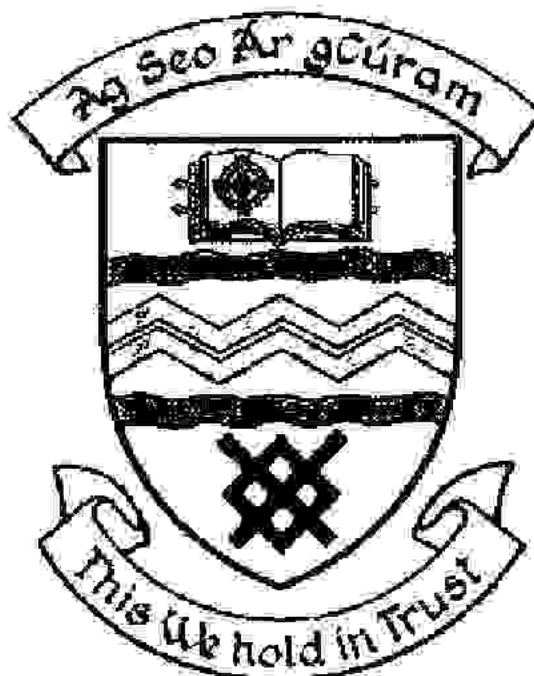

- 1 The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

**REASON:**

To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

- 2 The proposed development shall satisfy the requirements of the Environmental Services Department of the County Council in relation to the disposal of foul and surface water. In this regard, the applicant shall ensure complete separation of foul and surface water.

**REASON:**

In the interest of public health.

- 3 That the temporary classrooms shall be removed two years from the date of this permission unless a planning permission is obtained for continuation beyond this date.

**REASON:**

To allow a reasonable period of time to carry out the repair works to the school and in the interest of the amenities of the area, to avoid temporary structures continuing in place indefinitely.

- (1) All buildings must be designed and constructed in accordance with the Building Regulations 1997.
- (2) Building Control Regulations require a Commencement Notice. A copy of the Commencement Notice is attached.
- (3) A Fire Safety Certificate must be obtained from the Building Control Authority, where applicable.
- (4) Free Standing Walls must be designed and constructed in accordance with IS 325: Code of Practice for use of Masonry Part 1 : Structural use of unreinforced Masonry. The Owner must also ensure that the construction of all walls is supervised by a competent person.

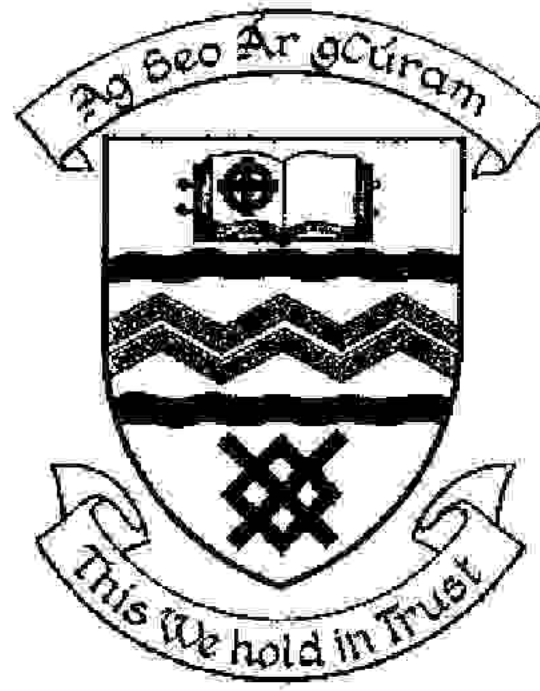
