
Reasons

- The proposed development would endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard due to additional traffic turning movements and parking, especially during the peak morning hours, on a busy district distributor road. This road is part of the strategic road network and will provide access/egress to the Southern Cross Network which is due to open before the end of the year.
- The visibility splays available at the access point are seriously substandard and the generation of additional traffic turning movements at this location would be hazardous.
- There is no public footpath in front of this property. The generation of pedestrian movements at this location would endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard.
- It is considered that the proposed development would seriously injure the amenities of and depreciate the value of property in the vicinity for reasons including additional traffic turning movements and additional noise.
- The subject site is located in an area zoned 'A' with the stated objective "to protect and/or improve residential amenity". Whereas a creche/nursery school is "open for consideration" within this zoning objective it is considered that this proposal materially contravenes the zoning objective for the area.
- It is considered that the proposed development materially contravenes Section 2.2.8 of the Development Plan which deals with Home Based Economic Activity including the childcare provision in residential areas. The requirements of this Section include that the use of the dwelling for childcare should be subordinate to the main use of the property as residential accommodation and that permission will only be granted to the resident of the house.
- An examination of the Planning Register for recent years does not indicate a permission for a change of use from residential to doctor's surgery on the subject site. The Page 2 of 3
