

APPEAL by Deirdre McGrane of 'Shalimar', Friarstown Lower, Bohernabreena, County Dublin against the decision made on the 5th day of September, 2000 by the Council of the County of South Dublin to refuse a permission for development comprising the construction of a dormer bungalow with Bio-cycle waste treatment unit with new vehicular access at Friarstown, Bohernabreena, County Dublin:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 to 1999, permission is hereby refused for the said development for the reasons set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

- 1. The proposed development is located in an area zoned "to protect and enhance the outstanding natural character of the Dublin Mountain Area" in the current South Dublin County Development Plan. Section 2.3.1(iii) of the Development Plan states the following:
 - "Within areas designated with zoning objective H ("to protect and enhance the outstanding natural character of the Dublin Mountain Area") dwellings will only be permitted where:
 - the applicant is a native of the area, and
 - the applicant can demonstrate a genuine need for housing in that particular area, and
 - the development is related directly to the area's amenity potential or to its use for agriculture, mountain or hill farming, and
 - the development would not prejudice the environmental capacity of the area, and that it be in keeping with the character of the mountain area."

It has not been demonstrated that the proposed development is directly related to the area's amenity potential or to its use for agriculture, mountain or hill farming, or that the proposal would not prejudice the environmental capacity of the area or be in keeping with the character of the mountain area. The erection of what is effectively a two-storey dwellinghouse unrelated to agriculture, mountain or hill farming, would contravene materially the zoning objective for the area and be contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.

2. The access way serving the site is deficient in width, alignment, drainage and lacks footpaths. The proposed access point is deficient with regard to the provision of adequate visibility. The traffic movements generated by the proposed development would, therefore, endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard.




