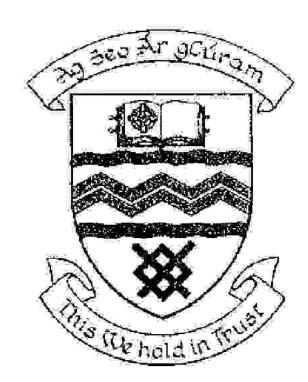

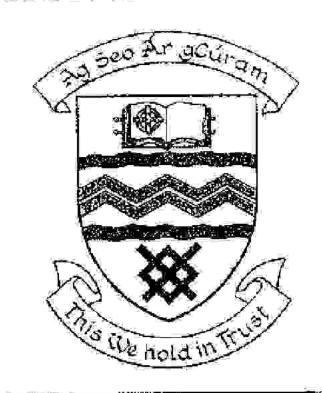

Conditions and Reasons

The development to be carried out in its entirety in 1 accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto. REASON:

To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

That the water supply and drainage arrangements, including 2 the disposal of surface water, be in accordance with the requirements of the South Dublin County Council.

Prior to the commencement of any development on the (a) site the applicant shall submit a revised layout plan showing full details of the proposed surface water drainage for each dwellinghouse.

The applicant shall ensure full and complete (d)separation of the foul and surface water drainage

systems.

All pipes shall be laid with a minimum cover of 1.2 (c)metres in roads, footpaths and driveways and 0.9 metres in open space. Where it is not possible to achieve these minimum covers, pipes shall be laid in C20 concrete 150mm thick.

REASON:

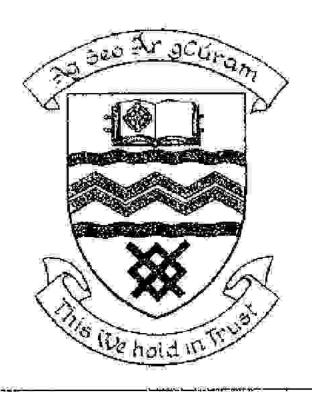
In order to comply with the Sanitary Services Acts, 1878 -1964.

- That each proposed house be used as a single dwelling unit. 3 REASON:
 - To prevent unauthorised development.
- That all necessary measures be taken by the contractor to 4prevent the spillage or deposit of clay, rubble or other debris on adjoining roads during the course of the works. REASON:

To protect the amenities of the area.

That no dwellinghouse be occupied until all the services have been connected thereto and are operational.

REASON:

In the interest of the proper planning and development of the area.

- That all public services to the proposed development, including electrical, telephone cables and equipment be located underground throughout the entire site.

 REASON:

 In the interest of amenity.
- That all watermain tappings, branch connections, swabbing and chlorination be carried out by the County Council's, Environmental Services Department and that the cost thereof be paid to South Dublin County Council before any development commences. Separate connections shall be provided for each dwellinghouse.

 REASON:

To comply with public health requirements and to ensure adequate standards of workmanship. As the provision of these services by the County Council will facilitate the proposed development it is considered reasonable that the Council should recoup the cost.

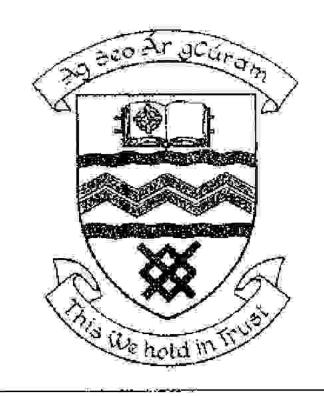
- The footpath and kerb of each proposed dwelling shall be dished to the satisfaction of the Area Engineer, Roads Maintenance. The driveway shall be constructed to the satisfaction of the Area Engineer.
 - (b) The gradient of the access (common area/driveway) shall not exceed 2.5% over the last 6 metres of approach to the back of the public pathway.

A low screen wall approx. 600mm in height shall be constructed along the front boundary of the proposed dwellings.

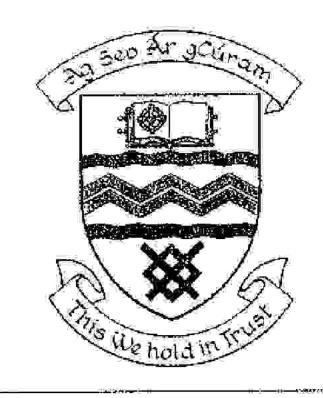

- 12 (a) No construction or site preparation work (other than demolition) shall be carried out on the site until all archaeological requirements of the Planning Authority have been complied with.
 - (b) The applicant shall have an archaeological assessment of the site of all proposed building carried out as soon as possible after demolition and before any construction work commences. The assessment shall be prepared by a qualified Archaeologist and shall address the following issues:
 - (i) The archaeological and historical background of the site.
 - (ii) The nature, extent and location of archaeological material on the site.
 - (iii) The impact of the proposed development on such archaeological material including the impact of the development on the archaeological amenity of adjacent monument/monuments.

The assessment shall be carried out on the basis of a site visit and on the basis of trial trenches excavated on site by an Archaeologist licensed under the National Monuments Acts 1930 - 1994 and such additional trial trenches as the Archaeologist shall deem necessary. The trial trenches shall be excavated in order to establish the depth of archaeological stratigraphy.

Where archaeological material is shown to be present, a detailed Impact Statement shall be prepared by the Archaeologist within, it will include specific information on the location, form, size and level (corrected to Ordnance Datum) of all foundation structures, ground beams, floor slabs, trenches for services, drains etc. No subsurface work shall be undertaken in the absence of the Archaeologist without his/her express consent.

- (c) A written report containing the results of the assessment shall be forwarded to the Planning Authority and to the National Monuments Service with full and final details of all proposed foundation structures.
- in writing and comply with all requirements of the National Monuments Service in relation proposed foundation structures and further archaeological requirements (including if necessary preservation in situ, excavation or monitoring). No construction or development related works including the excavation of service trenches, cable laying of drainage trenches should take place on site until written approval has been issued by the National Monuments Service with reference to the archaeological report.

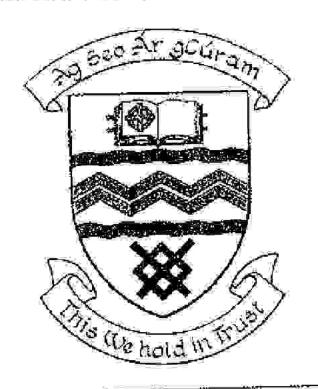
