

Reasons

- Having regard to the Development Plan requirements and inadequate provisions in this proposal for private open space, public open space, car parking and respect for the amenities of residential property in the vicinity, it is considered that the proposed development would constitute over-development of this restricted site, and would materially contravene development objectives of the 1998 South Dublin County Development Plan with regard to the provision of private open space and open space in apartment development. The proposal does not therefore conform with the proper planning and development of the area.
- The proposed development, which involves the erection of three storey apartment/duplex blocks in close proximity to the boundaries of a number of residential properties, will result in excessive overlooking. The proposed development would therefore seriously injure the amenities and depreciate the value of residential property in the vicinity.
