

APPEAL by Eamonn Grumley care of Vincent Traynor of 3 Castlebrook, Dundrum, Dublin against the decision made on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2000 by the Council of the County of South Dublin to grant subject to conditions a permission for development comprising retention of the continuance of the use of part of the storage area as a wholesale showroom and the retention of signage at the entrance walls, a free standing sign and signage on the building at Lucretia Tiles, Adamstown, Newcastle Road, Lucan, County Dublin in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:
