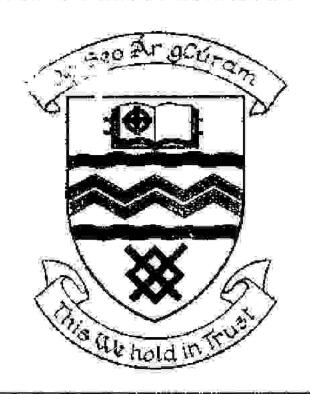

Reasons

- The public notices and the application form did not refer to the demolition of a substantial sized shed to the rear of the existing property. This is considered misleading and as a result contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.
