



Conditions and Reasons

The development to be carried out in its entirety in accordance with the plans, particulars and specifications lodged with the application and by way of additional information lodged on the 17/04/00, save as may be required by the other conditions attached hereto.

REASON:

To ensure that the development shall be in accordance with the permission and that effective control be maintained.

That all external finishes harmonise in colour and texture with the existing building.

REASON:

In the interest of visual amenity.

That the proposed decorative brickwork treatment indicated on Drawing No. 1901/P04 shall be omitted. Prior to development commencing the applicant shall submit revised drawings detailing an alternative elevational treatment similar to the existing shopfront, for the written agreement of the Planing Authority. Any security screens shall be of the open grille type and shall be provided so that no part of the shutter or its casing extends beyond the face of the building, and shall be treated with a colour to match that of the main shopfront materials.

REASON:

To ensure that the proposed development is consistent with the character of the Conservation Area in the interest of visual amenity.
