In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order... P/1705/78... dated 19/5/78 refuse:

for Additional bedrooms (alterations and extensions) at 33 Monastery Crescent,
Clondalkin, Co. Dublin.

for the following reasons:

1. There is a discrepancy between the site map and the detailed plans lodged with this application. As a result it is not clear to the Planning Authority to which house the application refers. In this regard it would not be possible to construct the proposed extension on the house identified on the site map or on the adjoining house which is 33 Monastery Crescent as there appears to be an unauthorised structure of different design under construction on this site.
