AFFEAL by George Cowen and Sons of Orchard Road, Clondalkin, County Dublin, against the decision made on the 13th day of July, 1978, by the Council of the County of Dublin deciding to refuse to grant a permission for the erection of a shop at Orchard Road, Clondalkin in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council:

DECISION: Pursuant to the Local Government (Planning and Development) Acts, 1963 and 1976, it is hereby decided, for the reasons set out in the First Schedule hereto, to grant permission for the erection of the said shop in accordance with the said plans and particulars, subject to the conditions specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the reasons for the imposition of the said conditions being as set out in column 2 of the said Second Schedule and the said permission is hereby granted subject to the said conditions.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

Provided the conditions in the Second Schedule are complied with, it is not considered that reconstruction and expansion of existing business premises, located in an area coned to provide for shopping and commercial development, would be injurious to the amenities of the area. or be otherwise contrary to the proper planning and development of the area.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE

#### Column 1 - Conditions

- 1. Parking bays numbered fifty-seven to sixty-four, inclusive and one to three, inclusive, on the lodged plans shall be omitted and replaced by landscaped areas.
- 2. Details of the loading bay and provision for refuse containers shall be as agreed with the planning authority.
- 3. The developers shall pay a sum of money to the Dublin County Council as a contribution towards the provision of a public water supply and piped sewerage facilities in the area. The amount to be peid and the time and method of payment shall be agreed between the developers and the said Council before the development is commenced or failing

#### Column 2 - Ressons for Conditions

- 1. In the interests of the visual emenities of the area and of traffic safety.
- 2. To ensure a proper standard of development.
- 3. The provision of such services in the area by the Council will facilitate the proposed development. It is considered reasonable that the developers should contribute towards the cost of providing the services.
