APPLICANT: **Clondalkin Inn Limited.**

In pursuance of its functions under the above mentioned Act the Dublin County Council, being the Planning Authority for the County Health District of Dublin, did by order **P/2590/78** dated **5th July 1978.** decide to refuse:

~~OUTLINE PERMISSION:~~ PERMISSION; ~~APPROVAL:~~

for **Proposed retention of illuminated fascia signs at The Laurels,**
Main Street, Clondalkin, Co. Dublin.

for the following reasons:

1. These illuminated fascia signs and their manner of operation endanger public safety by reason of a traffic hazard due to their distraction of both motorists and pedestrians at a substandard ~~by~~ and heavily trafficked junction. This traffic hazard is aggravated by the prominence of the site at this major junction.
2. This form of advertising sign is considered to be out of scale with the existing structures in the vicinity.

When an appeal has been duly made and has not been withdrawn the Minister for Local Government will determine the application for permission as if it had been made to him in the first instance.
