for the following reasons:  1. The site is located in an area zoned to preserve an area of high amenity open space" in the Development Plan. The presidential development proposed in this exposed location, where public piped water or sewerage facilities are not available and where the existing road network, designed to serve rural needs is inadequate, would contravene materially the above objective, would not be in accordance with the proper planning and development of the area and would seriously injure the amenities of the area.  2. No evidence has been submitted as to the applicant's need to reside in the area.  3. There are no public piped water or sewerage facilities available to serve the proposed development.  4. The proposed development would be premature by reason of the said existing deficiency in the provision of water and sewerage facilities and the period within which such deficiency may reasonably be expected to be made good.  5. The site is too small to satisfactorily accommodate septic tank drainage.  6. The site of the proposal is served by an inadequate road network. Any increase in traffic turning movements on this inadequate network would increase
